Barbara Pernici is full professor of Computer Engineering at Politecnico di Milano. She has a doctor in engineering degree (laurea) from Politecnico di Milano and a MS in Computer Science from Stanford University. Previously she was full professor at the University of Udine (1990-1993) and associate professor at Politecnico di Milano (1987-1990).

Her research interests include workflow information systems design, cooperative information systems, web based information systems and virtual enterprises, adaptive information systems and web services, data quality, office and information systems conceptual modeling, computer based design support tools, reuse of conceptual components, temporal databases, applications of database technology.

She has published more than 40 papers in international journals, co-edited twelve books, and published about 150 papers at international level..

She will be general chair of BPM 2008 in Milan.

She is member of the editorial board of the Requirements Engineering Journal, regional editor for the Journal on Cooperative Information Systems, and Editorial Review Member of the Journal on Database Management.

She serves as elected chair of IFIP TC8 Information Systems and of IFIP WG 8.1 (Information Systems Design and Evaluation).
